## **General Interest Form**for the **Southside Neighborhood Affordable Housing Initiative**

Duke is partnering with the city of Durham and local agencies to redevelop the Southside neighborhood in Durham as part of a program that will provide home ownership to eligible Duke University and Duke University Health System employees.

The program includes a \$10,000 forgivable loan from Duke and other assistance to employees who have worked continuously at Duke for at least five years and have an income less than 115 percent of the area median income (see table at right). Employees making 80 percent of the area median income (AMI) or less will qualify for additional subsidies and assistance, which could total as much as \$50,000.
